## Allocation of Secondary School Places 2019

For admissions to Year 7 in September 2019 all Local Authorities are required to co-ordinate secondary admissions for all maintained schools, Academies and Trust Schools.

I am sure that you are aware that it is a high birth year for children transferring to Secondary School in September 2019 which will mean more demand for places .

Once again we are encouraging more parents to apply online. Parents will not be receiving a copy of the booklet "Secondary Education in Coventry 2019". However, if parents require a copy of the booklet, a copy is held on the Coventry City website, the address is included in the leaflet to parents.

If you do not have your own computer you are able to access the computers at libraries throughout the City. They are available for use for 2 hours per day and staff are there to help you if you have any difficulties. They are also able to access computers in the Contact Centre at Broadgate House. Information regarding catchment areas can be found on the Coventry City website [www.coventry.gov.uk/schoolcontactdetails](http://www.coventry.gov.uk/schoolcontactdetails) **Children of parents / carers who fail to submit an application by the closing date will not be included in the initial allocation of places and the school(s) they have requested may be full with requests from parents/ carers who did meet the deadline.**

- ◆ All parents/carers will be notified by the Admissions Team if their application has been successful. Those who submit an application online will receive an email on 1 March 2019 and a letter will be posted 2nd class on 1 March 2019 to those parents who made a paper application .
- ◆ **You will appreciate that a change of address may affect the offer of a school place. It is important to keep your school office up to date with any changes .**

The decision regarding a secondary school place can only be made centrally because it depends upon the co-ordination of a lot of information and factors and that decisions will be made in accordance with the Authority's admissions policy. 16.04.19—School offer letters are posted today by 2nd class post .
