## Allocation of Secondary School Places 2019

- ◆ Application process starts from 01.09.18
- ◆ You must make your application before the closing date of 31.10.18
- ◆ All parents/carers will be notified by the Admissions Team if their application has been successful. Those who submit an application online will receive an email on 1 March 2019 and a letter will be posted 2nd class on 1 March 2019 to those parents who made a paper application .
- ◆ You will appreciate that a change of address may affect the offer of a school place. It is important to keep your school office up to date with any changes .

The decision regarding a secondary school place can only be made centrally because it depends upon the co-ordination of a lot of information and factors and that decisions will be made in accordance with the Authority's admissions policy. The Admissions policies for all schools are available on the Coventry City Council Website [www.coventry.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.coventry.gov.uk/schooladmissions).
